



## Overview of Results for Military Veteran Age 52



## Scores in Relation to the Norm and the Individual

These results are detailed in the tables that follow. These scores show how this veteran compares to the normative sample. They also provide an analysis of the variability of this veteran's scores on the separate CEFI Adult Scales. Differences between this veteran's average score and his standard scores on each scale are presented, as is a summary column that indicates whether or not these differences are statistically significant. If a standard score on any of the CEFI Adult Scales is greater than or equal to 110 and significantly higher than the client's average score on the CEFI Adult Scales, or less than 90 and significantly lower than the client's average score, then that score represents an Executive Function Strength or an Executive Function Weakness, respectively.
